Overview

Every year more than a quarter million people rely on Catholic Charities network of food pantries throughout Cook and Lake counties. Families and individuals who have nowhere to turn, and would otherwise go hungry, come to Catholic Charities food pantries when they are at their neediest.

Our food pantries contain a mix of donations and food purchased at a discounted rate from food depositories. In addition, ready to eat food is available for those who have no access to cooking facilities. Our sites offer periodic cooking demonstrations and recipes to clients, providing them with the most nutritious ways to prepare their food. Please call to determine days and hours pantry is open.

Some food pantry sites also serve as Emergency Assistance Centers providing rental assistance and clothing and household items. Services include:
