Overview

Gaining legal status as an immigrant and becoming a U.S. citizen are issues that concern millions of people across the country. Welcome, respect, and love are things that Catholic Charities is truly blessed to provide thousands of immigrants who seek help each year.

Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Chicago, Immigration and Naturalization Services is a Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA) recognized program since 1979 and provides a broad range of low cost immigration legal services to individuals eligible to receive immigration benefits. Immigration & Naturalization Services provides legal consultations and assistance regarding most immigration family matters.

Services

Catholic Charities provides legal consultations and assistance regarding most family immigration matters:

- Family based petitions: Adjustment of Status, Consular Process, and Removal of Condition from Residency
- Work Authorization
- Replacement/renewal of permanent residence cards
- Extension & Visa renewal
- Naturalization/citizenship
- Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)
- Temporary Protected Status (TPS)
- Client representation at the U.S.C.I.S. Chicago District office
- Inquiries for the status of cases at the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) offices and American embassies/consulates abroad
- Outreach and Education

Immigrant Survivors Project

Funded by the Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women (OVW), we provide services to survivors of: domestic violence, sexual assault, dating violence and stalking

- Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) allows an abused spouse or child of a U.S. Citizen or LPR or a parent of a U.S. Citizen to self-petition for lawful status
- U Visa services for individuals who are certified by a law enforcement agency as domestic violence survivors and to their qualifying family members, as appropriate
