Senior Food Nutrition Program

Overview

The Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) provides low-income seniors with coupons that can be exchanged for eligible foods at farmers' markets, roadside stands, and community supported agriculture programs. Participants must be Chicago residents who are 60 years and older and have an annual gross income at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Income guidelines.

The SFMNP was developed to provide fresh, nutritious, unprepared, locally grown fruits and vegetables to low-income seniors at nutritional risk. Coupons are distributed on a first come, first serve basis to participants through eight distribution sites and over 120 outreach sites, including senior residences.

Services

- Free fresh produce to supplement the diets of low-income seniors
- Nutrition education to improve and expand seniors' diets
- Information on how to select, store, and prepare fresh fruits and vegetables
- Health and social service referrals
