# Central States Institute of Addiction

## Overview

The Central States Institute of Addiction (CSI) performs evaluations, drug testing, and case management for driving under the influence (DUI) offenders. Since 1963, CSI has provided education and intervention by emphasizing the impact of substance use on the individual and the fabric of the family. CSI is recognized by many education, health, welfare, and enforcement agencies on a local, state and national level. CSI has also been involved in research on effective intervention for substance use disorders.

Central States Institute has helped change how society perceiving those suffering from substance use disorders. The treatment they receive not only restores their health, but also repairs all of the other consequences of their disease.

## Services

- **ALCOHOL AND DRUG EVALUATION SERVICES (ADES):** Located within the Cook County Court Districts, ADES evaluates DUI offenders referred by the Cook County Court, the Illinois Secretary of State's Office, and out-of-county/state jurisdictions. Professional assessments are conducted to determine the individual's level of impairment and subsequent risk to public safety. Following the assessment, recommendations are made to the individual and to the court. Services are provided in the client's primary language.
- **ALCOHOL AND DRUG SCREENING SERVICES (ADSS):** ADSS provides toxicology testing services to determine illicit drug use. A six-panel drug screen is used, and other assays may be incorporated depending on the needs of the referral source. Current referral sources include the Circuit Court of Cook County, private sector entities, and affiliated programs at Catholic Charities involved in drug-free workplace environments or upon court order. Locations include Bridgeview, Chicago, Maywood, Rolling Meadows, Markham, and Skokie.

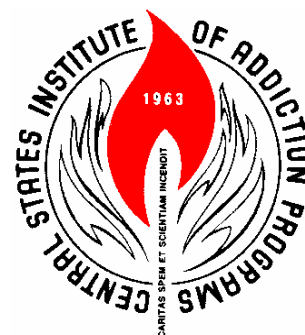
