

Ten things you should know about Catholic Charities Services to Latinos...



1. Catholic Charities helps anyone in need, regardless of religion, race or ethnicity.
2. We offer more than 150 programs at more than 160 locations throughout Cook and Lake counties.
3. 92 cents of every dollar donated to Catholic Charities is directed to our programs serving the poor.
4. We touch the lives of more than 230,000 Latinos annually; more than half are under the age of 18.
5. Regional offices in suburban Cook and Lake counties bring our services to the growing number of Latinos living outside Chicago.
6. Casa Catalina Basic Needs Center in the Back of the Yards neighborhood provides more than 900,000 meals to the community each year.
7. Our Child Development Centers prepare over 1,100 Latino preschoolers for kindergarten.
8. Each day, the St. Mary of Celle Family Center in Berwyn offers free computer and life skill classes that strengthen families and prepare individuals for the workplace.
9. Bishop Conway Residence (Humboldt Park) provides low-income Latino seniors with assisted living apartments and bilingual support services.
10. Our Immigration and Naturalization Services reunite families, assist them through the naturalization process and provide support to victims of domestic violence.
