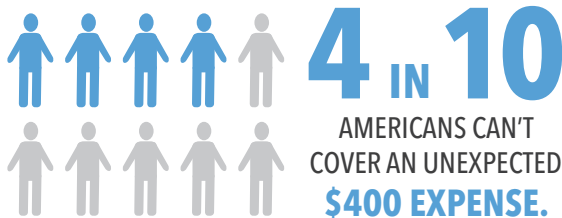

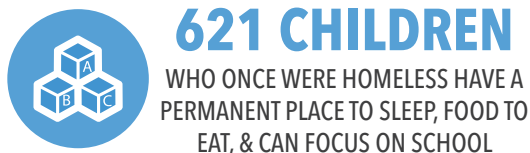

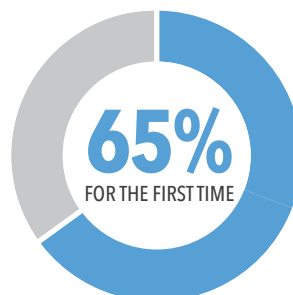
AN INDIVIDUAL'S CHANCE OF BECOMING HOMELESS WITHIN SIX MONTHS IS REDUCED BY
