CHA FamilyWorks

Overview

CHA FamilyWorks is a voluntary case coordination program for those living in Chicago Housing Authority residences. Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Chicago operates as a delegate agency for CHA FamilyWorks by addressing each client's individual needs. FamilyWorks was designed to target the primary areas of increasing earning power; developing academic achievement; increasing stability and quality of life; and increasing economic independence.

Services

The services provided by Catholic Charities under the FamilyWorks contract are intended to help residents remain lease compliant and promote self-sufficiency. Assistance includes, but is not limited to: intake, triage and assessment of housing, employment, and other barriers; youth engagement; senior services; clinical service needs; housing support; and lease compliance.

- **WORKFORCE SERVICES:** Catholic Charities provides job readiness training workshops, as well as monthly industry insider job clubs. In addition, residents receive interview attire and participate in onsite hiring events.
- **YOUTH SERVICES:** On-site programs for youth include an after school club, cooking classes, mentoring, community service programs, and mom and tots classes. Youth can also engage in summer employment programs, summer camp, and city exploration programs.
- **HOUSING:** Catholic Charities works closely with property management to help residents maintain their lease compliance and housing through case coordination, training, and workshops. Clients also receive appropriate referrals and resources as needed.
- **SENIOR SERVICES:** Health, wellness, and social events are hosted every month for seniors, including bingo, game days, and walking clubs. Catholic Charities and community partnerships provide workshops, including safety training, elder abuse and scam prevention, and senior insurance options.
- **CLINICAL SERVICES:** Individual counseling, crisis intervention, and clinical case management services are available for residents. Clinicians host group sessions and training series for residents, on topics including building healthy relationships, personal leadership development, and anti-bullying/violence prevention efforts.
