# New Hope Apartments

## **Overview**

Catholic Charities New Hope Apartments program is designed to end the cycle of homelessness by providing rapid rehousing with intensive case management services for homeless families with children under the age of 18. Through individualized service plans, clients focus on barriers to self-sufficiency, and work to increase income, decrease debt, and increase self-determination skills during their time in the program.

Through a combination of housing and supportive services, the staff of New Hope Apartments encourage participants to overcome any educational barriers to job success, build strong community relationships, raise healthy children, and fully participate in the program in order to overcome future challenges. By addressing the specialized needs within each household, New Hope Apartments dramatically changes families' lives, providing true "hope" for their futures.

## **Services**

- HOUSING: New Hope Apartments provides rapid rehousing for families with some income for up to 24 months. In suburban Cook County, New Hope Apartments also provides limited first stage housing for families with no source of income for up to nine months, and limited permanent supportive housing for families in which at least one member of the household has a disabling condition.
- **INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT:** Psychological barriers to self-sufficiency are addressed through monthly support groups, clinical case management, and/or access to individual counseling.
- LIFE SKILLS TRAINING: Clients are referred to employment and educational training.
- **BUDGETING/SAVINGS PLAN**: Volunteers from the banking industry address money management skills through monthly savings, budgeting, and debt reduction groups.
