Overview

Catholic Charities Home Delivered Meals/Meals on Wheels provides seniors who are homebound and unable to prepare their own food due to physical or mental difficulties with a nutritious lunch five days a week. Noon-time meals are prepared and delivered by volunteers to seniors throughout Cook and Lake counties.

Catholic Charities serves more than 250,000 home delivered meals annually. Thousands of seniors are able to continue to age safely in place and stay out of nursing homes. Volunteers deliver meals and provide valuable companionship to seniors who may be isolated. This personal, daily contact brings love and compassion while acting as a wellbeing check for seniors.

Eligibility

In order to receive meals, seniors must meet be the following requirements:

- Be 60 years or older
- Reside in Cook or Lake counties
- Have annual gross income at or below 130% of the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines
